
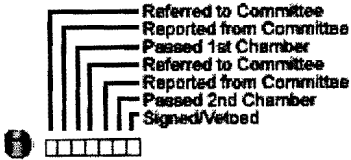

SB 285 David
----- Ritze Mandates that any person who enters the grounds of the Governor's

SB 324 Brown
----- Tibbs Forbids children under the age of 12 to operate any personal
watercraft, regardless of parental supervision; reduces the legal
